**Abstract:** The Joseph Allgaier collection spans the period from the late 1800's to about 1964 and primarily contains photographs relating to activities in the Albany area. The collection is divided into four series: News Photographs - Events; News Photographs - People; Studio Portraits; and Studios Outside Albany.

### Administrative Information

**Custodial History:** The collection came to the library on January 23, 1997. It was donated by Joseph Allgaier, town historian of the Town of Bethlehem. In a telephone interview with Francis S. "Doc" Rivett on June 16, 2003, Mr. Allgaier said that these photographs were among "50 to 60 cardboard boxes I found stored in the third floor of the [town] garage. I sorted out photos that concerned the Town and put them in my files. Not knowing what to do with them, I talked to Virginia Bowers, the city of Albany historian, and she suggested sending them to the Institute." Mr. Allgaier believes the news photographs originated in Morris Gerber's sales collection. They are consistent with the kinds of photographs Mr. Gerber offered for sale over the years. Mr. Allgaier did not know the history of the scores of photos, all lacking either date or identification, representing the work of studio photographers active in Albany in the late 1800's and early 1900's.

**Scope and Contents of the Records**

The Joseph Allgaier collection spans the period from the late 1800's to about 1964 and primarily contains photographs relating to activities in the Albany area.

**Organization of the Records**

The photographs are divided into four series: News Photographs - Events; News Photographs - People; Studio Portraits; and Studios Outside Albany.

Series I. [News photos – events, c. 1926-1935]

were so designated because the event rather than the persons made them newsworthy. They include two photos of a direct person-to-person blood transfusion in Memorial Hospital [10/8/1935] three photos of Josephine Brown n connection with a trial [c. 1926]; two photos of a coroner's inquest into the death of two Saratoga Springs teenaged women hit by a freight train as they cheered the departure of local troops [1940]; six photos of regulatory proceedings involving Rensselaer Water Company [n.d.]; photos of four funerals [1935].

Series II [News photos – people c.1931-c.1964]

were so designated because the person outweighed the event. These are divided into sub series as follows; Subseries1 – individuals; Subseries 2 – two people; Subseries 3 – three or more people. Identifying material follows the name in each instance.

Series III [Studio photos n.d.]



Subjects named are grouped by studio, noting its address. and, as determined from city directories, its approximate years of operation.

Series IV [Studio photos .n.d.] Subjects not named are grouped by studio, as in Series III.
