ALBANY INSTITUTE TO HOST PRESIDENTIAL BIOGRAPHER WILL SWIFT FOR LECTURE ABOUT NIXONS

ALBANY, NY- On Sunday, June 1, 2014 the Albany Institute of History & Art will host a lecture and book signing with author Will Swift about his book *Pat and Dick: The Nixons, an Intimate Portrait of a Marriage* (Threshold Editions, 2014). The lecture will begin at 2PM and is free with museum admission. This event is organized by the museum shop. Copies of the book will be available for purchase in the shop.

Will Swift is a historian, presidential biographer, and practicing clinical psychologist. He will give a fascinating talk about the challenges of researching and writing a nuanced portrait about the complex and enigmatic personal relationship between our controversial 37th President and his very private wife, the former Pat (nee Thelma) Ryan. Using previously unavailable letters and archives, Swift's recently published book shares deep insights into the 53 year marriage that sustained both Pat and Richard Nixon during his remarkable and turbulent political career.
