Description: Most articles summarize the accomplishments of the Chamber during its inaugural year. Other articles address the federal census. The Chamber reviewed census results and identified a significant number of inaccuracies. The clippings detail the mounting evidence and public/business support for a recount, due to the manipulation of congressional districts based on census results. Other topics include: licensure of farmers to sell goods on Albany streets; ordinances regarding the broadening/lengthening of city streets; examining board for licensing of stationary engineers; development of a carriageway over the Hudson River on the Livingston Avenue Bridge; overview of Albany in “The Coal Trade Journal”; campaign to encourage Albany tourism through advertising and the nationwide distribution of invitations; implementation of a railway transfer system; uniform charter for second-class cities.

Subject/Title: Chamber of Commerce	Dates: 1901 - 1902

Description: Articles document the refusal of the United Traction Company to grant transfer tickets to riders within the city’s railway system despite city ordinance, the effects of proposed changes to the route of the Erie Canal on local commerce and the lumber industry, and the debate regarding Schenectady Railway Company’s plea to gain entry to the city via tracks on Northern Boulevard. Articles also follow the closing of the American Cigar Company due to a female

worker strike aimed at the reinstatement of a dismissed foreman. Other topics include: CC's campaign to encourage Albany tourism and business/manufacturing growth through advertising, highlighted by articles in "The Inland Printer" and "Advertising Experience"; plans/efforts to add members to the CC; editorials espousing civic pride (mostly published in the 1901 Christmas edition of the Times Union); women's employment in local manufacturing; the damage and prevention of local area floods; request by General Electric employees for addition of a local train between Albany and Schenectady; a listing of the locations of bronze tablets marking historical sites throughout the city; examining board for licensing of stationary engineers; Albany's educational institutions, as showcased in the "New-York Daily Tribune"; visitors and tourists to the Capital district.

Subject/Title: Chamber of Commerce	Dates: 1902 - 1903

Description: Articles document an investigation by a Board of U.S. Army Engineers into the possible causes of and solutions to the formation of ice gorges along the Hudson River, which annually caused considerable damage due to flooding. The clippings detail the CC's proposal and appeal for donations to hire steamboats to plow an opening in the gorges. Other articles follow the debate over the pros and cons of proposed improvements to the Erie Canal, including an inland route via construction of the New York State Barge Canal through improvement of the Erie, the Oswego, the Champlain, and the Cayuga and Seneca Canals. Other topics include: CC's campaign to encourage Albany tourism and business/manufacturing growth through advertising, highlighted by articles in "Pacific Coast Advertising" and "The Phoenix," the presentation of a silver service set to the U.S. Cruiser Albany during a ceremony at the Brooklyn Navy Yard, the receipt of state monies to dredge the Albany basin and improve the river front, creation of a fund to support flood victims in Kansas City, Kansas, features on Albany attractions such as the Great Western Staircase in the Capitol and the Moses Fountain in Washington Park.

Description: Articles document the campaign for cleaner streets through ordinances regarding littering and waste removal and a 1904 amateur photo contest and exhibit held and organized by the CC. Clippings from “The American Amateur Photographer” and “The Focus” display some of the winning images. The articles also follow debates regarding issues such as the opening of drawbridges, the abolishment of Albany county tollgates, railway transfer tickets, and filtration of the water supply. Other topics include: CC’s campaign to encourage Albany tourism and business/manufacturing growth through advertising, highlighted by an article in “Municipal Journal and Engineer,” arsons, and a look back at the census figures from 1900.

Description: Articles document the battle between local shippers and the steamboat companies that carried freight between Albany and New York City. In light of increased freight rates, businessmen in Albany and Troy held back their freight from the People’s and Citizen’s lines and proposed creation their own independent boat line, extension of the trolley line into Arbor Hill. Other topics include: layoffs at the Watervliet Arsenal, proposed improvements to the river front, organizations to hold conferences in Albany, the campaign for cheaper gas rates and railroad rate regulation, selection of the site for the state educational building, and a possible ferry line from Rensselaer to Albany.
