### **Biography/History of**

Marcus T. Reynolds (1869-1937), son of Dexter Reynolds and grandson of Marcus Tullius Reynolds, was educated at St. Paul's School, Williams College, and Columbia University. One of Albany's foremost architects, he is known chiefly for his Delaware & Hudson and Albany Evening Journal Buildings along the Hudson River in downtown Albany, as well as a number of prominent bank buildings, public schools, and upper-class homes.
